

COOKIES POLICY

A cookie is a file that is downloaded on your computer when you access certain websites. Cookies allow a website, among other things, to store and retrieve information about the browsing habits of a user or their devices and, depending on the information contained and how devices are used, cookies can be used to recognise the user. The user's browser stores cookies on the hard drive only during the current session, occupying minimal memory space and not harming the computer. The cookies do not contain any specific personal information, and most of them are deleted from the hard drive at the end of the browser session (so-called session cookies).

Most browsers accept cookies by default. In any case, users can allow or block temporary or stored cookies using the security settings of their browsers.

WHAT TYPES OF COOKIES ARE USED ON THIS WEBSITE?

- Personalised cookies: These allow the user to access the service with some general features that are predefined according to a set of criteria in the user's terminal, such as the language, the type of browser through which the user accesses the service, the regional configuration from which the user accesses the service, etc.

The user also acknowledges the possibility of refusing the use of the said data or information by disabling the use of Cookies by selecting the appropriate settings for such purpose in the browser. However, blocking cookies on a browser may prevent the user from having access to the all the website's features.
